- Fostering Learning in Operator Communities (FLOC) Program Initiative

 - Multiple members of the committee can work on these separately, so we have a selection to submit throughout the year.

- Core Conference 2024
 - o The date is Thursday, March 21st.

- 2024 Operator's Challenge
 - Part 1: Hydromantis WWTP Simulator. There are 9 pre-programed WWTP problems from Hydromantis that need to be troubleshooted. Each problem has a set points value. The operators can complete as many problems as possible in the event timeframe.
 - o Part 2: American Pump Repair to provide equipment for a pump impeller change and tolerance check.
 - Tyler and Richard will coordinate the event logistics and details with Elisha @ APR, including when and where to set up the crane truck and pump activity and how to allocate and score 100 points for the event (i.e. verbal Q&A or quantifiable speed and correctness of the impeller change).
 - Venue is Aqua Indiana's Hancock County Facility
 - o Occurs on May 14th, 2024 with Facility open for setup on May 13
 - Seven Event Rounds, goal is 14 Teams, therefore dual teams for each 1-hr.
 round. Event score based on 200 points total possible.
 - Vanessa, Richard, and Tyler volunteered to facilitate the events during the challenge. Katie is also available if needed.
 - Awards: we need to brainstorm an award for the winners!
 - Richard will reach out to various manufacturers for cast iron replicas of equipment to mount to a trophy base.
 - Tina Wolff offered to order trophy bases or plaques that we can use to mount the awards to.
 - Richard will forward this email to the committee, so we can discuss and decide what should be ordered.
