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Job Description

Overhauls and repairs plant equipment and machinery, which includes performing electrical and mechanical repairs on plumbing, pneumatic and hydraulic equipment, HVAC, and other equipment in the plant. Performs diagnostic tests. Performs preventative maintenance of plant equipment and machinery, including changing oil, greasing, and alignment, checking for proper operation of equipment and cleaning, as necessary. Mows grass and weeds, removes trees and brush, and performs other related grounds keeping duties of a seasonal nature, including snow and ice removal. Evaluates plant equipment for electrical problems and performs light to medium wiring repairs or replacements, as required. Maintains records of issues and repairs using electronic work order system. Relays equipment and machinery issues to the Maintenance Coordinator when repair or replacement parts are needed. Communicates with the Maintenance Coordinator with regard to issues with PPE, replacement parts, equipment and tools required to perform assigned tasks.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

OTHER REQUIREMENTS - Ability to legally drive and operate a variety of vehicles and equipment (Ability to obtain a Class B CDL within one year of hire). *Please note that in accordance with federal regulations, the selected candidate must successfully pass a Department of Transportation drug screen prior to employment.*

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE - High school education or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities. Minimum experience equal to one year in water/waste water treatment or related occupation, preferred. Experience with 480 volt electric service and control panels is preferred. Experience with maintaining pumps and pneumatic and hydraulic equipment, required. Experience diagnosing electrical and mechanical failures, preferred. Experience with performing light to medium wiring repairs or replacements as required. Experience in changing oil, greasing equipment, and cleaning equipment.

KNOWLEDGE/ABILITIES - Knowledge of applicable safety precautions and procedures, including lock-out tag out, fall protection and confined space entry procedures. Required to wear all types of personal protective equipment. Ability to read and understand blueprints, mechanical and electrical. Ability to obtain working knowledge of wastewater treatment plant operations and equipment maintenance needed, both routine and emergency. Physical ability to work in varying environments, indoors and out, and sometimes work in cramped and/or awkward positions.
